

The Management, Professional Staff and the Delanco Skating Club invite you to participate in the New Jersey Open Invitational. The date for this year's event is *May 10 & 11, 2025*. The invitational will include all USARS Youth Level A, B, and C Events, all USARS Adult Events, Eastern Region Intro Events, and the Eastern Region Youth Development Program. We will skate the first and second requirements as listed for the April 1st National Elimination Draw. Senior, Junior, Cadet and Youth figure events will not have a national draw listed. They will skate all figures as listed for the Regional Draw.

All USA Roller Skating rules will be followed as outlined for the 2025 National Roller Skating Championships. You may register for as many events as you can at the 2025 Regional Championships but not more.

Entry fees are \$35.00 for the first event and \$30.00 for each additional event. All World Skate entry fees are \$45.00 for every event. A \$15.00 fee will be charged additionally for combined events.

Entry deadline is April 15, 2025.

All spectators will be charged a \$5.00 admission fee.

Custom Medallion Awards will be presented to all 1st, 2nd, 3rd place winners. All contestants registered in the Eastern Region Youth Development Program will receive a Custom Medallion Award.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

All skaters must hold a current 2025 USA Roller Skating Full Membership Card or an Event Only Competition Membership if they are registering in official USARS events. (Youth Level A and B events, World Skate, Youth Events, Elite Events and all Adult Events). Skaters registering in just Eastern Region Youth Development Program Events or Level C events may skate with a Star Skate USA Roller Sports Membership (\$15.00). Skaters who have a Single Event Only USA Roller Sports Membership (\$25.00) may compete in as many events as they qualify to skate at the NJ Open Invitational only. If using a Single Event membership, it is only good for five days so do not purchase it before May 7, 2025.

- Official Event Skaters can only register for events as if they are filling out a regional application. Adults can register for 1
 Bronze, 1 Silver and/or 1 Gold Event per discipline for a total of two entries. They may enter the age appropriate Bronze and
 Silver event or Silver and Gold event. If skating a Bronze event, they may not skate a Gold event. They may also enter one
 additional Classic event per discipline. Adults may also enter either or both of the Special Adult Dance Events. Primary A,
 Juvenile A and Elementary A may challenge up to the next higher A event. Freshman A and Sophomore A may only challenge
 up to Junior, World Skate or Advanced events (as eligible by age). Level C skaters with full USARS membership may
 challenge up to Level B. Level B skaters may challenge up to Level A.
- 2) All official events will be run using the official national rules.
- 3) Espoir, Cadet, Youth, Junior and Senior World Skate Freeskating Events will skate both short and long programs.
- 4) World Skate Dance Events will skate all of their requirements.

INTRO EVENT (Tot Freeskating)

Ages 7 and Under

Time: Music maximum time is 2:00 Minutes plus or minus 5 seconds. Music: Any music may be used, including vocal, as long as content is deemed appropriate. Content: Only single and ½ jumps allowed. Only upright spins allowed.

Intermediate Fresh/Soph Coed Figures

This is an unofficial COED figure event for skaters ages 13 and over. It is intended to help bridge the gap between Fresh/Soph C and Fresh/Soph B figure requirements.

Special Adult Dance Events (Updates 3/20/25)

In addition to the regular USARS Solo and Team Dance events there will be an additional two solo and two team dance events. These events will be open to adult skaters 18 and over. Adult Special 1 Solo Dance will skate the Swing Waltz and Carey Foxtrot. Adult Special 2 Solo Dance two will skate Double Cross and City Blues. Adult Special 1 Team Dance will skate the Pilgram Waltz and Tara Tango. Adult Special 2 Team Dance two will skate Monterey Tango and Memorial Waltz. In addition to entering your USARS Solo and Team Dance Events you may also enter either one or both of these Special Events.



(about 4 miles, exit is at a WAWA Store) Make a right at the end of the exit and a quick left at the next street. The skating center is on the right ¼ mile down the road.
- West PA Turnpike across bridge into New Jersey. Get off at the first exit after the bridge onto Rt. 130 South. Follow Rt. 130 South to Creek Road exit. (about 4 miles, exit is at a WAWA Store) Make a right at the end of the exit and a quick left at the next street. The skating center is on the right ¼ mile down the road.
- South- NJ Turnpike North to Exit 4, Rt. 73 North to Rt. 130 North, Rt. 130 North to Delanco (about 4 or 5 miles) to Creek Road Jug Handle Exit. Follow Creek Rd. after exiting Rt. 130 - Turn left at first street (about 300 yards) - The skating center is on the right ¼ mile down the road.
