All applications **MUST** be fully completed with amateur card numbers and signatures.

All applications **MUST** be postmarked by May 9, 2025.

When registering, skaters MUST use their name EXACTLY AS IT appears on their amateur card. (NO NICKNAMES)

ERYDP may skate with a Star Skate, Limited or a Full USA Roller Sports membership.

NO OUTSIDE food may be brought into the building.

NO GLASS containers may be used for drinks. All food and drinks MUST be kept in the snack bar area.

Solo Dance

All events will be skated as final events no matter how many skaters are registered.

Level 1

- 1. Outside edges down the straightaway and Corner steps for the Glide Waltz around the corner. 108 Waltz Tempo. Skater will perform 1 Repetition or ½ way around the floor.
- 2. Inside Forward edges on the Straightaway, to 3 progressive runs, Drop Chasse on the corner. 92 Foxtrot Tempo. Skater will perform 1 Repetition or ½ way around the floor. Skaters will skate one at a time.

Please note that only skaters that pass the test will receive a pass medal. Skaters that fail the test will receive a participation award.

Level 2

- 1. Glide Waltz 108 Waltz. Skater will perform 2 Repetitions or once around the floor
- 2. Progressive Tango 100 Tango. Skater will perform 2 Repetitions or once around the floor.

Skaters will skate one at a time.

Level 3

- ${\bf 1.} \quad \text{Balanciaga 100 Schottische. Skater will perform 2 Repetitions or once around the floor.}$
- 2. City Blues 88 Blues. Skater will perform 2 Repetitions or once around the floor.

Skaters will skate one at a time.

Free Skating

All events will be skated as final events no matter how many skaters are registered.

Level 1 Free Skating

- 1. Jump: 1/2 Turning 2-Foot Jump
- 2. Forward Crosses: Counterclockwise
- 3. Body Movement: Spiral
- 4. Footwork: Left Outside Forward Swing, Right Outside Forward Swing, Left Outside Forward Swing, Right Outside Forward Swing, RIF to LIB Mohawk Turn, Change Feet, ROB to LOF Mohawk Turn (Edges are not required for the Mohawk Turns)
- 5. Spin: 2 Foot Spin (From a standing position or spread eagle & must be at least 2 times around)

Level 2 Free Skating

- 1. Jump: Waltz Jump
- 2. Body Movement: Backwards Spiral
- 3. Forward Crosses: Clockwise
- 4. Jump: 1/2 Toe Loop (Landing on 2 feet)
- 5. Footwork: RIF Mohawk-LIB Mohawk, ROB-LOF, Bunny Hop, Bunny Hop then (The Skater will perform the sequence twice in a counterclockwise circle)
- 6. Spin: LIB Upright (The spin must be at least 2 times around)

Level 3 Free Skating

- 1. Jump: Salchow
- 2. Body Movement: Spiral to Shoot the Duck or Tuck Position
- 3. Crosses: Backward Crosses, Clockwise
- 4. Combination: Bunny Hop, Waltz, Full Toe Loop
- 5. Spin: ROB Upright (From a standstill)
- 6. Footwork: RIF Mohawk-LIB Mohawk, ROB-LOF Mohawk, Bunny Hop, LOF- LIB Three-Turn, step forward, LIF Mohawk-RIB Mohawk, LOB-ROF Mohawk, Bunny Hop, ROF-RIB Three-Turn (Pattern is in a "S")
- 7. Jump: Toe Loop
- 8. Spin: LIB-RIF Upright (Each position must be at least 2 times around)








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MAP AND DIRECTIONS



FROM THE:

- North NJ Turnpike South to Exit 6 (PA Turnpike Extension Exit), Exit off of the extension before getting into PA on the Rt. 130 South Exit. Follow Rt. 130 South to Creek Road exit. (about 4 miles, exit is at a WAWA Store) Make a right at the end of the exit and a quick left at the next street. The skating center is on the right ¼ mile down the road.
- West PA Turnpike across bridge into New Jersey. Get off at the first exit after the bridge onto Rt. 130 South. Follow Rt. 130 South to Creek Road exit. (about 4 miles, exit is at a WAWA Store) Make a right at the end of the exit and a quick left at the next street. The skating center is on the right 1/4 mile down the road.
- South- NJ Turnpike North to Exit 4, Rt. 73 North to Rt. 130 North, Rt. 130 North to Delanco (about 4 or 5 miles) to Creek Road Jug Handle Exit. Follow Creek Rd. after exiting Rt. 130 Turn left at first street (about 300 yards) The skating center is on the right ½ mile down the road.

If you are using a GPS navigation system or Map Quest.com to get to the skating center the address is 1775 Creek Road, Edgewater Park, NJ. Our mailing address is Delanco, NJ but there is another Creek Road in Delanco and it will take you to the wrong Creek Road. (Our parking lot is in Edgewater Park.)
